- President

- Past President
- Secretary
- Finance Officer

The term of office is:

- One year for the President-elect, and Immediate Past-President
- Two years for all other officers, including the President

The Board of Directors also includes representative from each Province and Territory (if available).

Membership in the Canadian Nurses Association is required for all Board of Director members.
